UPDATE: ACCESS HEALTH CT CEO JAMES WADLEIGH SHARES NUMBERS FROM THIRD WEEK OF OPEN ENROLLMENT

CEO shares enrollment numbers from week three of 2017 open enrollment

Hartford, Conn. (November 18, 2016) – Today, Access Health CT (AHCT) CEO James Wadleigh shared updated enrollment statistics. These numbers come at the close of the third week of the fourth annual open enrollment.

During the 2017 open enrollment period, CEO Wadleigh, will be providing weekly updates of enrollment statistics and enrollment metrics, detailing a number of things from call center contact metrics to plan enrollment and utilization. Below please find a chart detailing current enrollment numbers from Tuesday, November 1st through the close of business November 17th.

AHCT CEO James Wadleigh would like to also remind Connecticut residents that currently, there are no changes to the law. “If you have health insurance through the exchange, you are still covered. If you don’t, we encourage you to reach out and enroll now.

If there’s any future change, we will adapt and evolve with the best interest of our customers at the core of every decision we make. As for right now, it’s business as usual. Open enrollment is happening, customers are enrolling, and we encourage them to continue to do so until the final enrollment deadline on January 31st, 2017.”
